
#### Purpose




- The Tribe is a group of like-minded people who have more in common than they have differences.



#### Developmental Feedback






- 1. Make sure it is developmental (positive improvement)
- 2. Be timely (present moment)
- 3. Prepare ahead of time (clarity)
- 4. Be specific (do not use generalities)
- 5. Do it in private (safe and comfortable)
- 6. Limit the focus (specific and direct)
- 7. Reinforce (share positive actions to embed)
- 8. Show Caring (be authentic)

#### Motivation and Goals




- Intrinsic Value is direct result of an individual's desired goal.

Level III – Beyond Level II + understands the SAM Principles


Level IV - Beyond Level III + mastery/excellence
